Pure Chicago: "Hidden" beaches of Rogers Park provide a natural oasis in Chicago all summer, complete with dunes and walking trails

Close to Morse & Loyola Red Line stops, unique dining and independent shops

CHICAGO (June 25, 2018)—Hidden in plain sight on Chicago's North Side, **Rogers Park beaches** stretch for nearly a mile alongside Loyola Park complete with walking trails, natural dunes, picnic grounds, a fishing pier and lighthouse. Located a half-mile walk from the Morse and Loyola Red Line stops, the relaxing beaches are near unique restaurants and pubs, independent shops, the vibrant Mile of Murals and the Glenwood Sunday Farmers Market.
