A. WHAT IS A SSA?

A SSA is a designated area in which property owners choose to provide additional services for the benefit of residents, merchants, and visitors. A fee is applied to properties within the SSA. The funds collected go directly back into the district based on local priorities.

Howard Street includes a trove of long-standing businesses that celebrate Rogers Park's diversity, history and rich cultural makeup.









The area presents an eclectic mix of shops, community spaces, transit access, and parks – all the ingredients of a vibrant shopping district











RPBA and SSA #19 serve local businesses through organizing events, providing business support, addressing safety concerns etc.







2. Where is your home, business or property located:





More small businesses with a commitment to improving and participating in the community - sol café, smack dab and common cup do a great job with this.

I think investment in small business is crucial; we want the neighborhood to keep its vibrant, diverse identity intact without gentrification.

More safe social gathering locations and events (e.g. coffee houses, bars, block parties, plays in the park)

Help current businesses become more professional and well known (retail, restaurant, entertainment) to draw those outside of the Rogers Park area.

Continued beautification of the area, especially around Howard. More public art prioritizing artists in the Rogers Park community.

I would love to **holiday lighting carried over to Jarvis Square**. **Improvement of crime and safety** as this often deters me from visiting Howard more often.

Anything art oriented! The pole designs would be wonderful to distinguish Jarvis square as a place to visit.

Coordination of neighborhood marketing, raising our profile and delivering quality community experiences to **showcase our neighborhood as a destination for visitors and residents to support our small business.**

D. Cost

Advisory Committee Recommended Maintaining Existing Rate Cap

Current Tax Rate Cap: 0.833%

2019 Rate: 0.6398%

Examples

\$50,000 EAV x 0.006398 = \$320 per year or \$26 per month \$100,000 EAV x 0.006398 = \$639 per year or \$53 per month
