Rogers Park announces business specials for Small Business Saturday kicking off the holiday rebate program **Live Love Shop Rogers Park**

Holiday shopping rebates up to \$75 are eligible between Nov. 26 – Dec. 31, 2022; Small Business Saturday holiday kickoff will feature free hot beverages, live music, a 3D photo wall, in addition to dozens of local store promotions and discounts, for one day only on Nov. 26

A Live Love Shop Rogers Park **holiday kickoff** will begin at a Welcome Station hosted at The Common Cup (1501 W. Rogers Park Business Alliance’s shop local campaigns such as Live Love Shop Rogers Park make a visible impact on building a strong local business community. In the 2021 Live Love Shop Rogers Park campaign, more than **520 transactions** were recorded at **143 independently-owned businesses** within Rogers Park. Over **\$26,000** was spent with **\$17,680** staying in the Rogers Park community.

Live Love Shop Rogers Park offers rebates to shoppers who patronize **independently owned** businesses in Rogers Park during the holiday season. From November 26 through December 31, customers who shop at independently owned Rogers Park stores are eligible for a rebate based on the total amount spent. **Those who collect \$150 or more in receipts will receive a \$50 rebate, and those with receipts totaling \$200 or more will receive a \$75 rebate.** To qualify for the rebate, a completed rebate form and original receipts (hard copy or digital/email confirmation dated between November 26 and December 31, 2022; no gift receipts allowed) must be turned in to RPBA by Friday, January 6, 2023, by 4 p.m. Shoppers can download the PDF form, or pick up a hardcopy from RPBA’s office (1448 W. Morse Ave.) then mail the completed form along with the receipts to RPBA. For more information and detailed rebate rules, visit rpba.org/live-love-shop.
