The annual Jarvis Square Music and Arts Festival returns to Rogers Park with artisan vendors, live music, and food

CHICAGO (June 20, 2025) – The nonprofit **Rogers Park Business Alliance** (RPBA) is honored to support its community of neighbors and business owners in Jarvis Square as they present the return of the popular **Jarvis Square Music and Arts Festival** on <u>Saturday, July 19th from 1 – 10 p.m.</u> The Festival will transform Jarvis Square (1500 W Jarvis Avenue) into a bustling hub of creativity, music, and food.
